Much of this music, particularly the pieces by Saint-Saens and the Strauss, is commonly found in arrangements for music students. Our hope is that students who attend the concert after having learned some of the repertoire on their own instruments will feel a deeper connection to the music and a heightened excitement about music study.

The student simply needs to learn one of these themes from the concert in an arrangement appropriate for the current instructional level. As the music teacher you will sign a form indicating that the student has mastered the piece according to your standards. Forms are available on the HSO website <http://hanoversymphonyorchestra.org> and also at Menchey Music Service in Hanover. Each student who meets the criteria will receive two free tickets. In addition, the teacher will receive a free ticket for each form submitted (limit of two tickets per teacher). Forms must be postmarked on or by March 1, 2012. Tickets will be held at the "Will Call" window at The Eich on the day of the concert.

To assist you in selecting music for your students, Menchey Music Service in Hanover will have a "Night at the Carnival" display with sheet music available for various instruments. If you have any questions about the project, please feel free to call HSO member Susan Bagot at 717-632-1810.
